


Photo No. 3 - Royal Jungle Cart of India drawn by two bulls. The riders are the Giraffe neck women, who were guest attractions during this period. This photo was taken from the 1934 Hagenbeck-Wallace Circus program, and would indicate that the cart was used prior to 1934 as well as during the 1937 and 1938 seasons.

This cart was used for a few years by the great Hagenbeck-Wallace Circus. As I can recall it when the many years I saw this circus in the 30's it was used as a feature around the hippodrome track of the big top. If my memory is correct, it carried one of the giraffe neck women from Burma and Princess Mu Kaun and Prince Dah. I believe this was 1933.

The photos used in this article show two versions of this wagon. Photo number two shows the cart before it was stripped of many of its original spring gears. (This photo is from the R. J. Bernard List). Photo number one shows the cart in its last year on the road with much of the spring attachment missing. There is no question that this type of spring gear was a problem. (Photo number one is an Eddie Jackson photo).

This wagon in some years was hauled by two bulls as seen in photo number one, but I also can recall it was hauled by two steer bulls with long horns which may have been sacred cows or zebus.

So let's try this for a change and add something to the show for your spec. or super attraction. I use this for an attraction and is hauled by two oxen. It carries a giraffe neck woman and a dipper lipped Ubangi.







5 PCS. TO ASSEMBLY

END VIEW SHOWING CENTER SPRING TO AXLE









WHEEL ASSEMBLY



SPOKES ARE ROUND - MAKE 2 PER SET.

SET IN WHEEL SAME IN HUB

COVER SPOKES WITH DISK (1") ON EDGE OF SPOKES AND FITTED ON INSIDE OF WHEEL CASE OR RIM.

3" WIDE

THERE IS NO STEEL TIRE THE WHEEL IS OF HARD WOOD
