

The Five Graces wagon was originally on the Adam Forepaugh Circus in the 1870' and 1880's. It was originally a telescoping statuary wagon but was converted to a bandwagon in about 1880. It eventually was used on the Ringling Bros. and the Hagenbeck-Wallace shows.

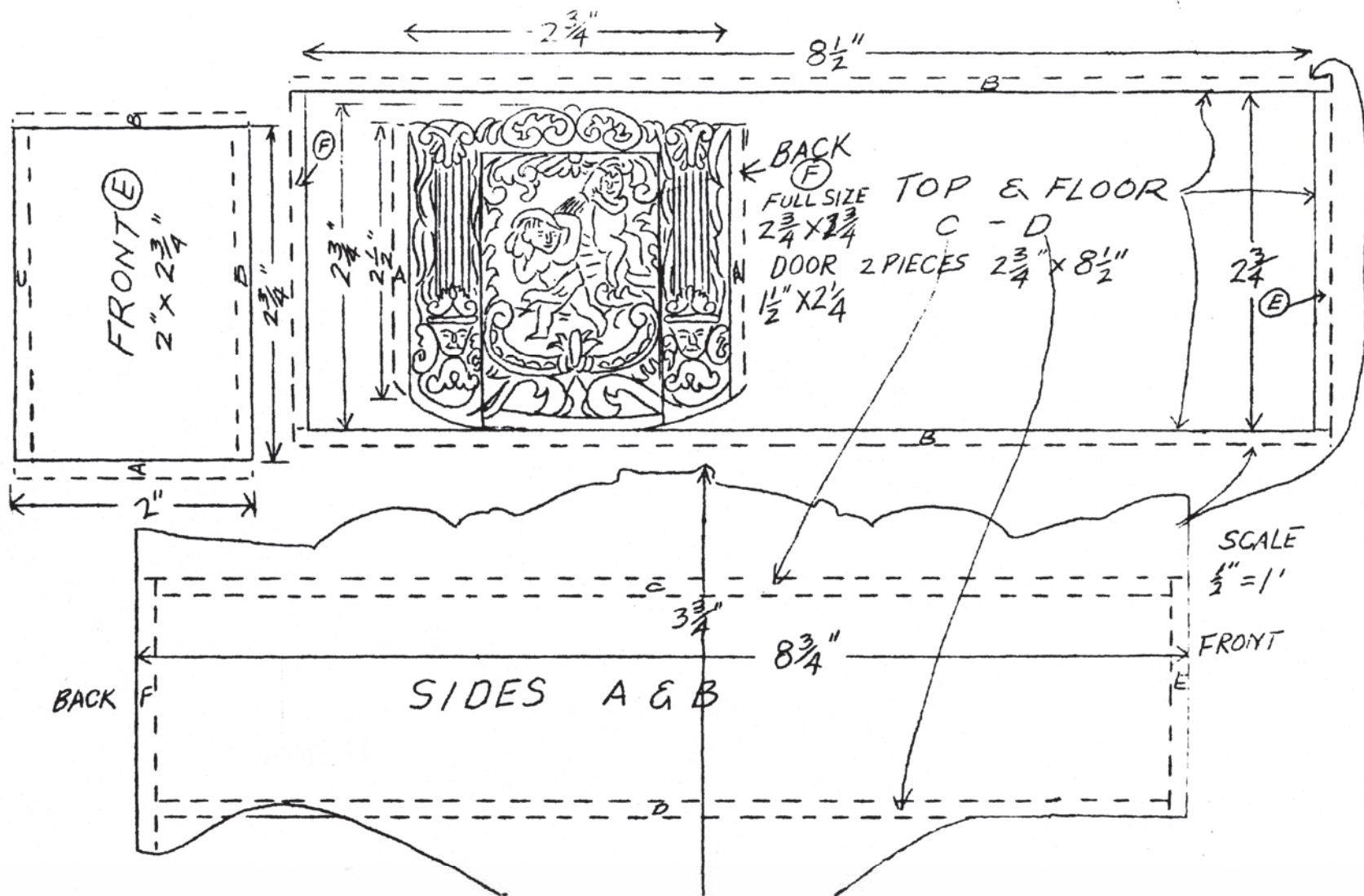
