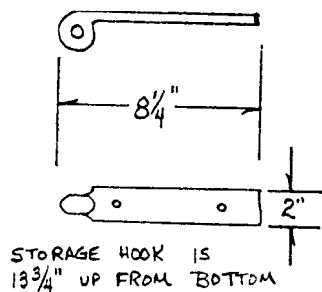

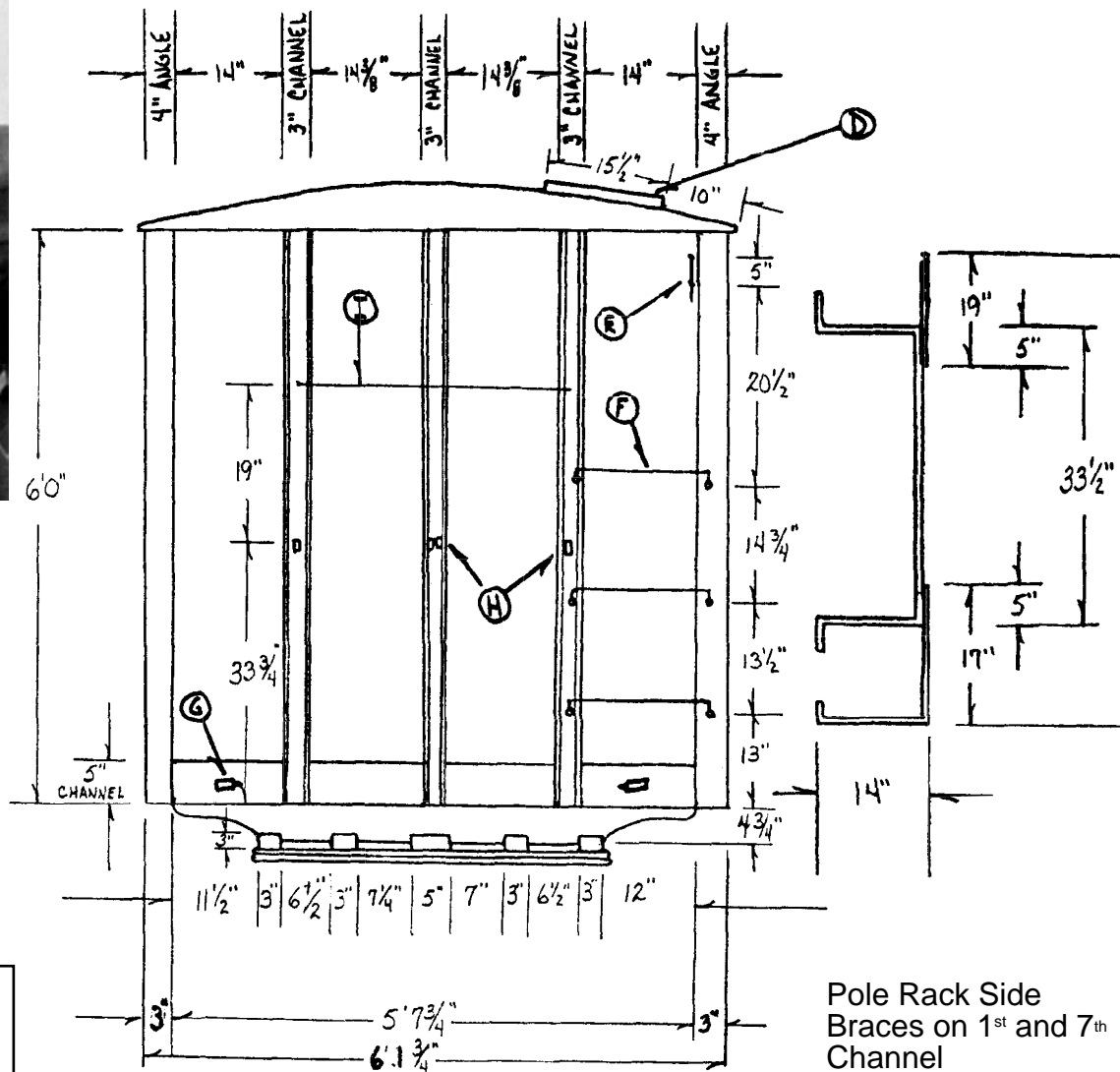

2 1/2" WIDE STEEL STRAP (OUTER)

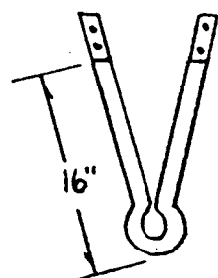

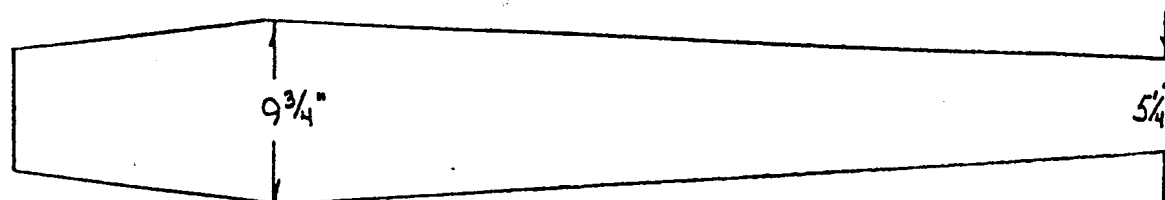
3" WIDE STEEL STRAP (INNER)

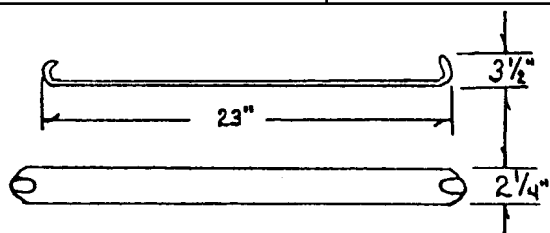

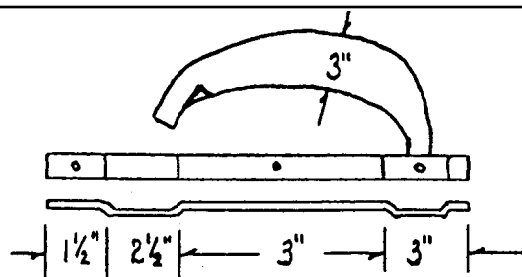

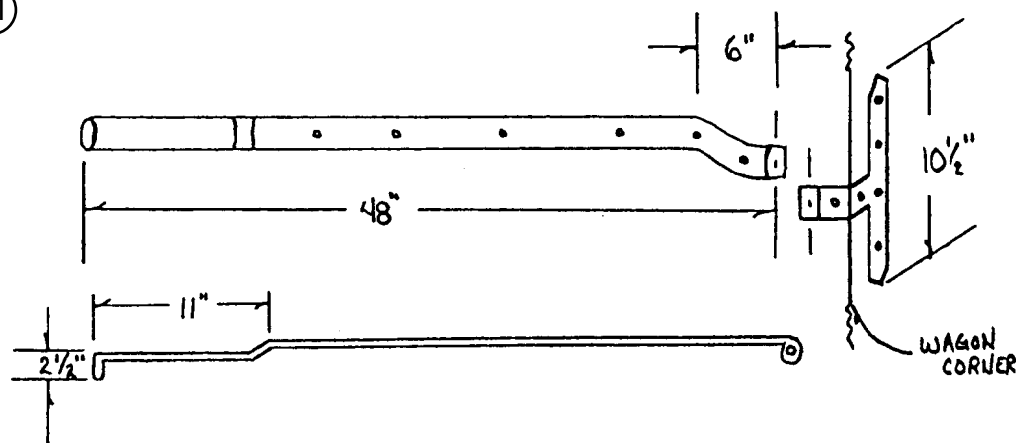
