

Again I come with a grand old wagon of ages past. This is one of a fabulous series of cages of the John Robinson Big 10 SHOWS of the 1900's. According to a well known circus historian the late Richard Conover there were sixteen of these wagons. One was a snake den and not the cottage type. Four of these cages were twenty foot long. (At this date, I am started on the sixteenth cage for my collection.)

The side view of the drawing comes from the late CMB Charles Lockier. With these drawings (these were in one half inch scale) I have applied these in actual measurements. The front and rear I have found these from other photos on my collection and have drawn these to the best I could.
