

So, we are presenting a Work Table Jack, used inside of the Cook Top. There were usually two of these under each of the work tables which were 2 ft. wide and about 10 ft. long. There were some others of shorter length.

I believe the drawings speak for themselves. As to the hinges, I use the stringed tape used for sealing boxes cut to size. The Jacks were held in position with rope as shown on drawing, knotted at ends. All stock is dressed 1" thick and 4" wide. Next time we will do the table tops and also some shorter Jacks.
