Original Drawing Notes:

- Drawing is 1" = 1'
- Everything that goes on the model is the size that appears on the drawing.
- Rear Wheels -----3"
- Front Wheels -----2 3/8"
- Axles -----5"
- Platform length -----7 1/2"
- Width -----3 1/4"
- Pole -----7"














Rear View
