

Notes:

This is a 3-Section cage that is used to separate animals of different breeds. Three types of bears, etc. are put in this type of cage.

This type was used on the Hagenbeck-Wallace Circus in 1933. They had three bears in the cage at that time.

The base color is red. Markings are of gold bronze. The wheels are white with a green line on the spokes and dots of yellow dots on a red background between the spokes.

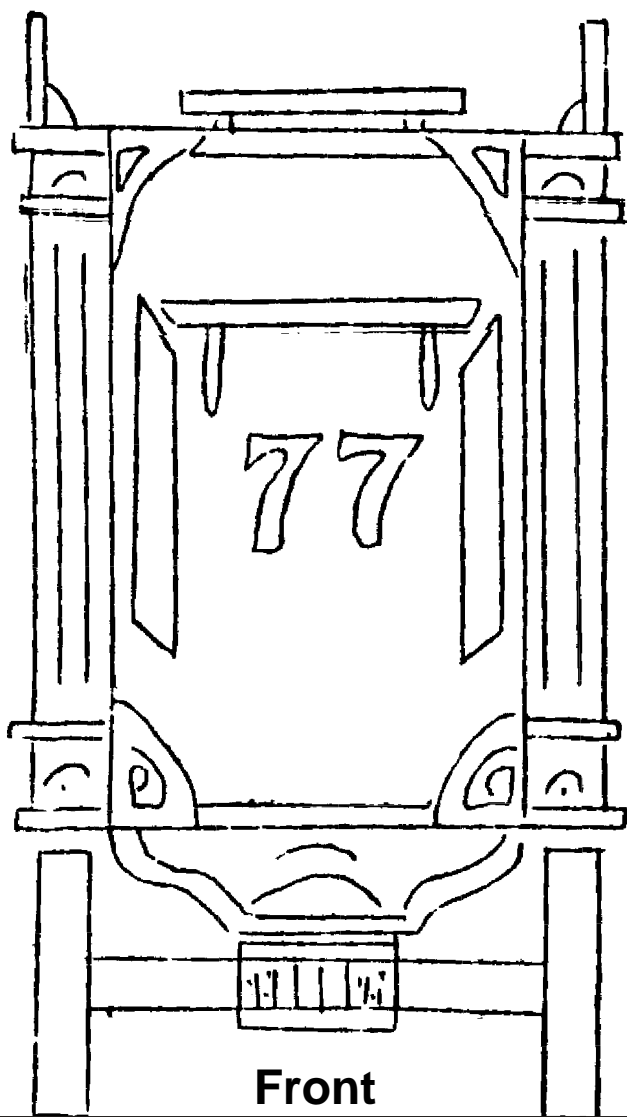

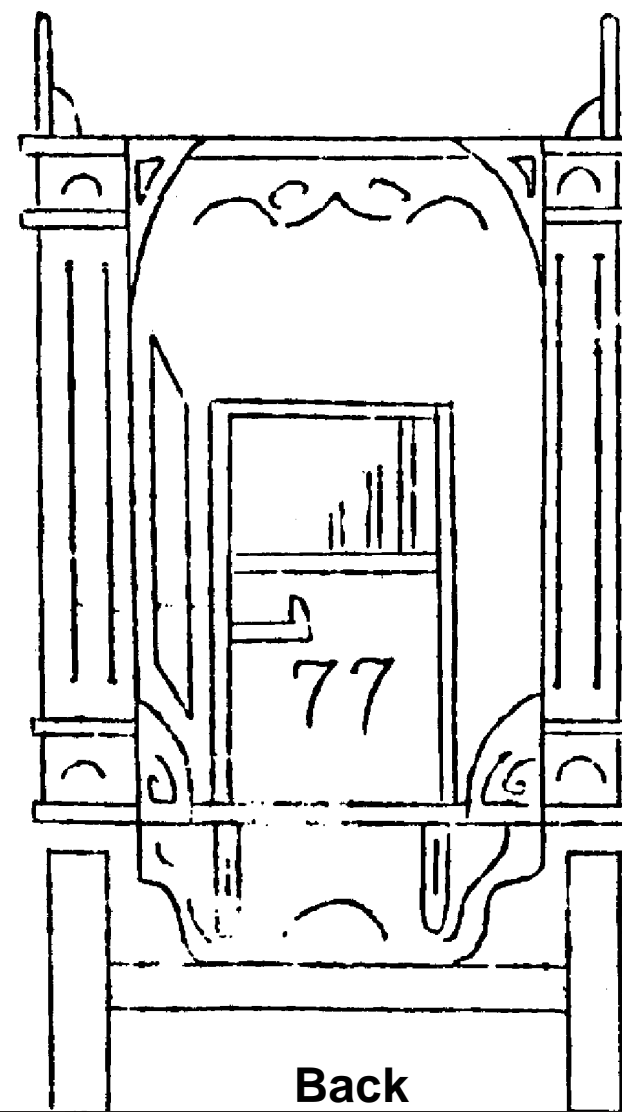
