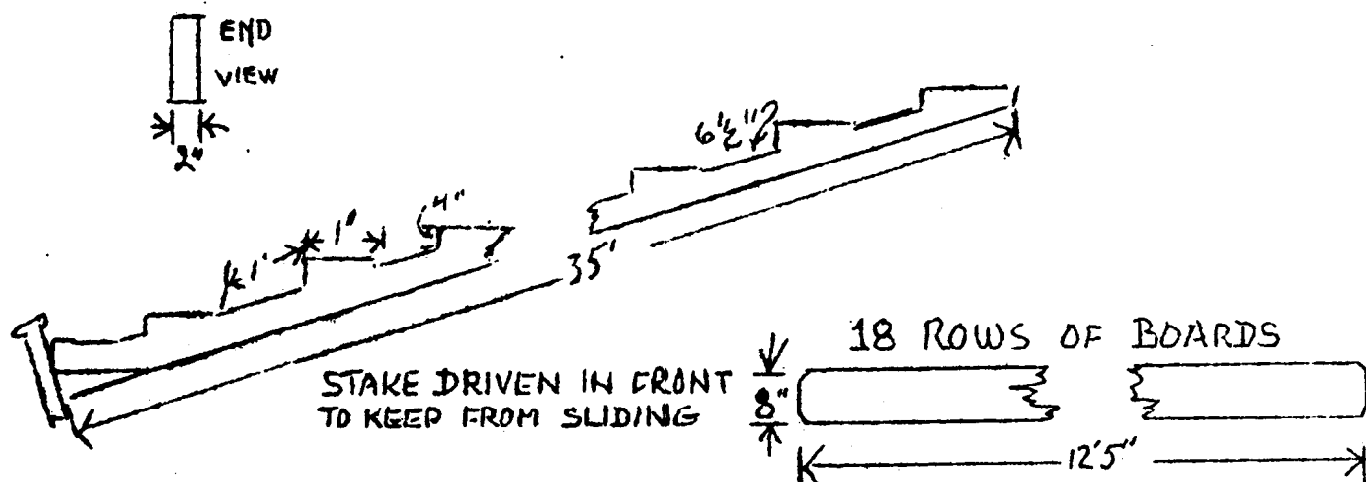
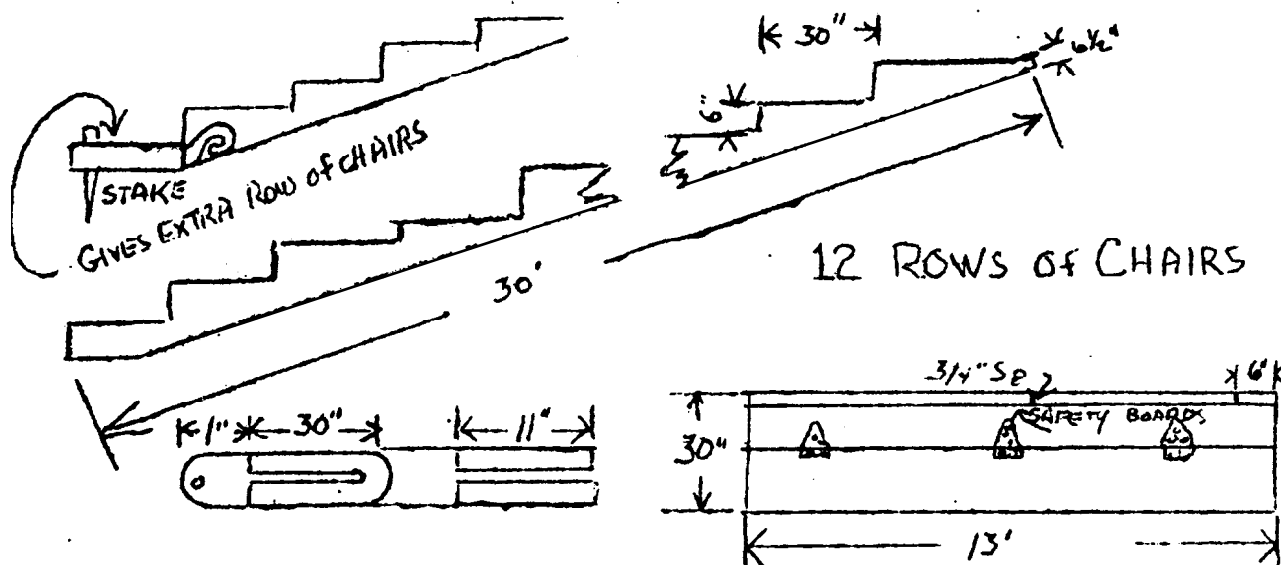


General Admission Seats (Blues)

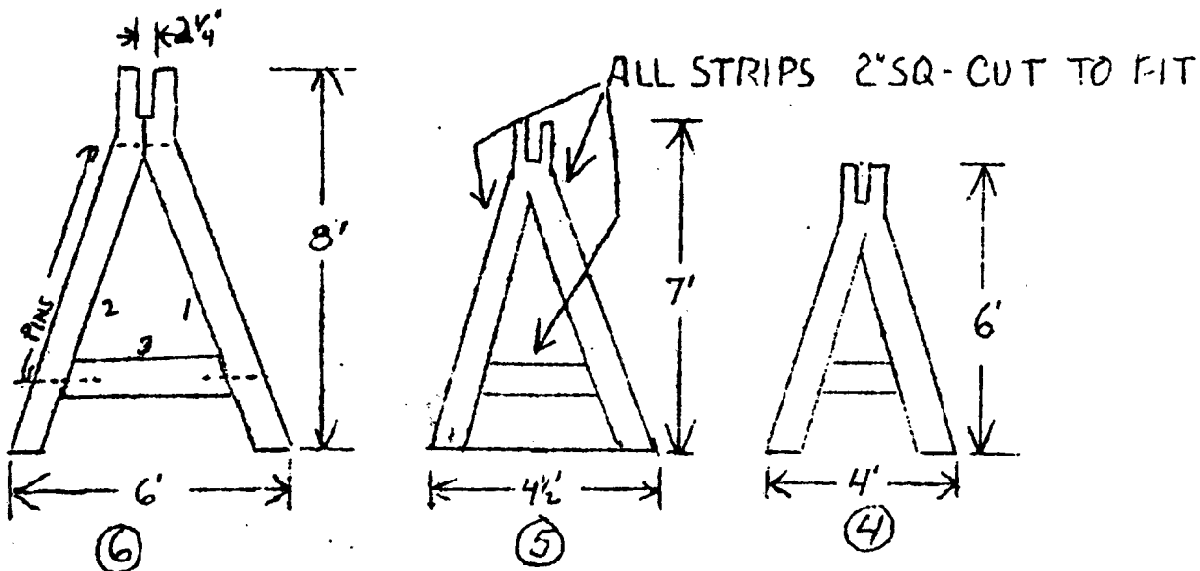
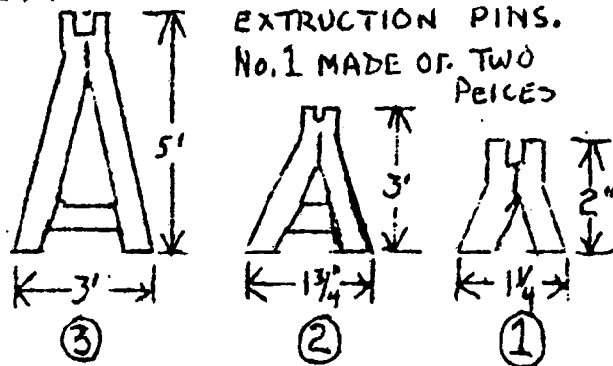

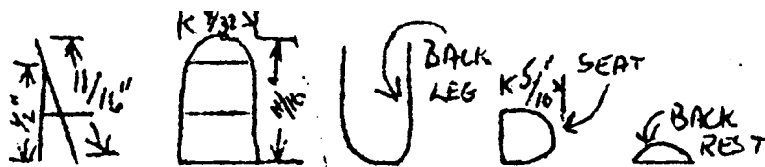
Jacks (Used on both Reds & Blues)

JACKS MADE IN THREE PIECES
GLUED OR TACKED TOGETHER WITH
EXTRUCTION PINS.
No. 1 MADE OF TWO
PIECES

All jacks were made of metal but these plans are made so that they can be made of wood. The same applies to the stringers.



Chairs - All metal Reserved seats



Note: Seat and back rest are made of tin or thin sheet metal and soldered to the chair. All of the rest of the chair is made from copper tinned wire so that it will easy to solder. Small forms can be made out of scrap metal to make the front and back legs. Jigs can be used for soldering.
