



This comes from Rev. Maurice Allaire. Maurice says, he saw this on a model lot layout a number of years ago and said that it really contributed to the lot appearance. Maurice and I felt that this would bring back some nostalgia to the older members who may remember seeing this item on a lot or even seeing it used.

I believe the drawing is self explanatory. The boards as you can tell are grooved in the side rail and are held in place by the bolts from one side rail to the other side rail. The runner can be painted if you are working in a small scale or you might use aluminum from a pop can or whatever.
